

# Imagination Station

Grades K-2



This interdisciplinary program explores the relationship between music and visual art, spotlighting students' imagination as the foundation of an artistic experience. Specially designed as an accessible-for-all option, students will learn to communicate how they experience music through art-making processes such as painting, collage and line-drawing.

Throughout the program, students will learn about music from around the world, identify themes, emotions and stories from musical selections and draw the connections between music and art as mediums of expression.
